JUST A THOUGHT:

Dear Fellow Traveller,

Christmas for us in the northern hemisphere will always be associated with short hours of daylight, a watery sun giving little heat, rain, sleet and even snow, all of which adds up to colder weather. We try to put on more and warmer clothes, but we need heat and food to keep us warm.

This particular Christmas, due to factors beyond our control, providing any kind of heat in our homes has become expensive. Add to that food, which enables us to generate some bodyheat, has also increased enormously. The poor and the homeless in our society find themselves in the worst of all situation. The Covid years have shown that we do look out for our neighbours and for those who most need help, like the thousands of Ukranian refugees driven out of their country with practically nothing.

The fact that Jesus chose to be born in mid-Winter, during a census-taking meant that Mary and Joseph had to travel many days journey on foot in the cold in order to reach their of registration in Bethlehem. This must indicate that God meant his Son to be identified with the poorest and most needy of his time. As we approach Christmas we think of the poor and those in need both at home and abroad.

We encourage people to think about how they will celebrate Christmas. In terms of our parish we will have 6 Masses - three on Christmas Eve [4p.m (Children); 6p.m. 8p.m and Three on Christmas morning.[9:30am; 11a.m. 12:30p.m. We invite all who may have a desire to worship to come to one of the community gatherings, be they regulars or once a year person. It will be good to be together. It is especially appropriate for families to come together, and be with us - all those away and those who live in Salthill
