We may all have the idea that monasteries are sacred magical places where you find wise, contented people dedicating their lives to God. However, we all have to deal with our human failings no matter where we go. There was this monastery with a large community of monks. There was this monk called Br Jack who was difficult to get along with. Jack was argumentative and critical of many other monks and practices in the monastery. Finally, the Abbot convinced him to go away to a far away monastery for a retreat. This was not unusual for monks to move about to different monasteries, so he went as requested.

While on retreat he started to see life from a different perspective. He became more patient and caring. Then the time came for him to return to his home monastery and the monks were weary of his return. He settled back into his daily routine of work and prayer. The other monks gave him a wide berth and avoided him where possible. When they did have to engage, they treated him as before. Br. Jack grew frustrated and never got a chance to show them how he had changed. They presumed that he was still that bad tempered monk. After a long while Br. Jack resorted to his old state again in order to fit in. Clearly the monks had a picture of him in their minds that prevented them from seeing the change.

The story is asking us to re-examine how we view everyone in our lives. Often when we meet someone out of context, we struggle to remember their name. We fail to see the person behind the role.

When we meet another we could try and meet them as if for the first time.
